### Changes

- The cloud service for the Sonos V1 media library has been replaced by a local version on the dSS.
- The cloud service for the vDC device configuration pages has been replaced by a local version on the dSS.

### Possible effects

- The "text2speech" functionality for Sonos V1 now works in the same way as for Sonos V2, in that a generated mp3 must be uploaded.
- All standard actions of the vDCs are automatically adopted. Self-generated actions, if available, must be newly created. Custom Actions and User Defined Actions can still be created or changed via the respective dSS app.

## Installation Notes


### dSS and dSM

- Execute the software update from the digitalSTROM configurator within the menu "*System / System Update*".
- The dSS must be connected to the Internet in order to perform the update. Alternatively, the update can be installed by using a USB thumb drive.
- It is advisable to back up your system settings prior to performing a system update within the menu "*System / System Maintenance*".
- Once the system updates are installed, the system checks again for available updates. In case there are additional dSM firmware updates available, they must be installed manually by clicking the "*Update System*" button.
